

- b. Edward M. Calvo Cancer Foundation \$ 660,000
  - i. Dr. Naputi moved to award Edward Calvo Foundation. Mr. Felix seconded the motion.
    - Motion carried and Edward M. Calvo Cancer Foundation has been approved.
- c. Guam Cancer Care (Direct Services) \$1,168,184
  - i. Mr. Felix moved to award Guam Cancer Care. Dr. Naputi seconded the motion.
    - Motion carried and Guam Cancer Care has been approved.
- d. Catholic Social Services \$391,593 ---- \$130,000
  - i. Mr. Felix moved to award Catholic Social Services. Dr. Naputi seconded the motion.

- e. Todu Guam (Direct Services) \$<del>1,526,164</del> ---- \$1,015,738
  - i. <u>Discussion:</u> Counsil members briefly went over the conditions as to the reduction. Initial plans were to do a six-month contract with half of the amount to bring your organization fully operational. Depending on the functionality of your program on that six-month mark, plans to addendum the contract to add another six months and the rest of the funds will take effect. Otherwise, they will need to revisit and consider other programs.
    - Motion carried and Todu Guam Foundation has been approved
      - with the conditions discussed.
  - We will give 6-month contract for half the amount ... must show proof that they are up and running by 4 months... by 6 months they should be submitting monthly invoices equal to "\$1,015,738" divided by 12 months .... Subject to legal review...
- f. American Cancer Society (Direct Services) \$230,322 ---- \$70,667.50
  - i. Mr. Felix moved to award Guam Cancer Care. Dr. Naputi seconded the motion. - Motion carried and American Cancer Society has been approved.
